Koonwarra Poll Ram 22-191, held by Jono alongside Digby, Toby, Zoe and Anna, was awarded Grand Champion August Shorn Fine Wool Ram, after winning Champion August Shorn Fine Wool Poll Merino Ram, at the Australian Sheep and Wool Show at Bendigo in July.

Thank you to all buyers and under-bidders for their terrific support during 2023 at both our Koonwarra and Merrignee on-property ram sales as well as very good support for our paddock/flock ram sales. Our loyal clients – many of whom have been with us since we commenced C.T. Merriman & Son in 1990 – are much appreciated.

It is very pleasing to receive such good feedback on our stock and to have new people coming to inspect and buy. There has been terrific feedback on the quality of wool on both the Koonwarra and Merrignee sheep and their ability to be productive in all climatic conditions, especially around their wool coping so well in extremely wet conditions.

NEWS FROM THE FARM

2024 has been a very good show year for both Koonwarra and Merrignee Merino and Poll Merino Studs, which has been very pleasing for us all here at C.T. Merriman & Son.

The show year started in February with **GREAT SOUTHERN SUPREME MERINO** (GSSM) at Bathurst Showground, its new home. The move from Canberra was a positive one for the event and a particularly successful one for our studs with Merrignee "Brocky" crowned Supreme Exhibit in a unanimous decision with the fine wool judge commenting, "It's pretty hard to find a fault in this sheep. He oozes strength and depth". The ribbons our stud's took home from GSSM included:

- Merrignee ram "Brocky" 21-087: Supreme Exhibit via Champion March Shorn Fine Merino Ram. Progeny of "Brocky" will be available in this year's Merrignee ram sale group.
- Merrignee ram "Tank" 21-189: Champion March Shorn Superfine Ram. "Tank" will also have progeny on offer at Merrignee's upcoming on-property ram sale.
- Merrignee ram NP 22-189: Champion August Shorn Superfine Poll Merino Ram.
- Koonwarra Poll ram 22-191: Champion August Shorn Fine/Medium Poll Merino Ram.
- Koonwarra ram 22-194: Reserve Champion August Shorn Fine/Medium Merino Ram.

Moving onto the **SYDNEY ROYAL EASTER SHOW** in April, MGN "Brocky" continued his success, alongside some other pleasing results including:

- Merrignee "Brocky" 21-087: Grand Champion Fine Wool Merino Ram where he was shorn, cutting 14.6kgs, and testing 17.2 microns, 2.7 SD, 15.8 CV, 99.8% CF and 16.0 SpinF.
- Merrignee "MK" 21-641: Reserve Grand Champion Superfine Merino Ram.
- Merrignee NP 22-189: Reserve Grand Champion Ultrafine Poll Merino Ram, after winning Reserve Champion Ultrafine August Shorn Poll Merino Ram.
- Koonwarra Poll 21-001: Reserve Grand Champion Fine Poll Merino Ram.

The new show season saw us head to the AUSTRALIAN SHEEP AND WOOL SHOW in Bendigo mid-July 2024 with both Koonwarra and Merrignee Merino and Poll Merino Stud sheep. With studs attending from across Australia, including Tasmania, Queensland and Western Australia, ensuring robust classes, we were very pleased to walk away with four ribbons, including:

- Koonwarra Poll ram 22-191: Champion August Shorn Fine Wool Merino Ram, after winning Champion August Shorn Fine Wool Poll Merino Ram.
- Koonwarra horn ram 22-136: Reserve Champion August Shorn Fine Wool Merino Ram.

• Merrignee Poll ewe 22-453: Reserve Champion March Shorn Superfine Wool Poll Merino Ewe.

At the Bendigo sale, Merrignee offered two rams. Lot 104, a superfine Poll ram, sold to four New South Wales Merino studs – Conrayn, Hillcreston, Demondrille and Shalimar Park – while Lot 105, an ultrafine horn ram, was sold to Conrayn Stud. The buyers said they were impressed with the excellent style of these rams fleeces, with the Poll ram heading straight to Boorowa Vet Clinic to collect some quality semen.

August is a busy period full of events. Jono headed to **HAMILTON SHEEPVENTION** on the first weekend of the month with display groups from both studs. The five rams from each stud were well received by the public and our clientele down in Victoria. There was also a good level of interest and positive comments on how the sheep had been presenting over the last three years from other studs attending the event.

Next up was **RABOBANK NATIONAL**

MERINO SHEEP SHOW in Dubbo on 27th and 28th August, where we took show teams from Koonwarra and Merrignee as well as fleeces from both studs. This event was capped off with a Merrignee superfine ewe fleece beating out 60 entries to be crowned the Supreme Champion Fleece Exhibit. From a ewe shown at GSSM earlier in the year, the ewe's fleece weighed 8.1kgs skirted while scoring eight from a possible 10 points for trueness to breed, conformity of length, handle, character and style, and evenness, nine out of 10 for soundness and 27 of 30 for clean fleece weight. Other awards from Dubbo included:

• Koonwarra Poll ram 22-191: Champion August Shorn Fine Wool Merino Ram (the same award he received at Bendigo), plus Reserve Grand Champion August Shorn Merino Ram against a line up of 10 rams from four states in Australia. From the KWA RP family, he has progeny on the ground with tests of 18.3 micron, 2.7SD, 14,6 CV and 99.9% CV.

Last September KOONWARRA MERINO AND POLL MERINO STUD had a strong ram

selling season. At the 46th annual on-property sale, 108 rams sold from the 120 May/June 2022 drop offered, for an average of \$2,199 (ex. GST). The top price of the sale was \$5,000 (ex. GST) for Lot 2. By Nerstane 043, his fleece tested 17.8 micron and 99% CF with a body weight of 98kg, while his meat indexes measured at 43mm depth and 90mm width.

Last October **MERRIGNEE MERINO AND POLL MERINO STUD** had solid demand for its 12-month-old August/ September 2022 drop rams. At the 33rd annual on-property ram sale, 83 of the 90 rams offered sold under auction for an average price of \$2,247 (ex. GST). Lot 2, the top priced ram, sold for \$7,500 (ex. GST). By MGN "Magic" family 19-107 "Big Super", he tested 16.7 micron, 2.0 SD, 12.1 CV, 15.3 SpinF and 99.7% CF.

NEWS FROM KOONWARRA

The Koonwarra genetics continue to impress here at Little Range and for clients of the stud, proving they are highly productive, producing great quality, quantity and style of wool on large, framed ewes. Highly fertile and with great mothering ability year-after-year, no matter what the environment throws at them, they are able to consistently produce high quality and stylish wools, while still producing quality lambing percentages. This consistency provides a level of confidence that is critical to ever-evolving farming enterprises.

The blue tagged young rams being offered at Koonwarra's upcoming on-property sale, as well as flock sales later in the year, were born in May/June 2023. Born into a good season with feed in front of them, these rams have been able to express their genetics, impressing us as they have grown into this year's sale rams.

We have had a lot of good feedback from clients, agents and fellow Merino breeders on the direction and quality that is available from the Koonwarra genetics in both the horn and Poll side of the stud's genetics. We feel that this year's team of sale rams are an outstanding line up that will impress those that inspect them.

We did need to feed the flock twins through their lambing six weeks which had an impact on the twin survival rate.

KOONWARRA'S UPCOMING RAM SALE

We intend to offer up to 120 young rams from the Koonwarra May/June 2023 drop. As usual, our 2024 Koonwarra sale rams have been outside in the environment their whole lives (besides the few head selected as show sheep for the March tagging system). Their pastures have been supplemented with oats through a lick feeder, pasture hay and minerals as required to meet their feed needs.

The first and only shearing for this year's sale rams was done on 19th April 2024, providing the fleece weight percentage for each ram's figures. This is the third year where the rams will be shorn only once prior to sale. Before 2022, sale rams were shorn twice, once in late October and again in mid-April.

The rams were side sampled and weighed in the first week of August 2024, with testing undertaken by Riverina Wool Testers in Wagga Wagga to collate each ram's fleece and body figures for the sale. Meat scanning (width, depth and fat) and a final body weight will be undertaken just prior to the preview day. All figures will be available via cards above each pen and in the Koonwarra on-property ram sale catalogue.

2024 KOONWARRA SALE RAM GENETICS

For the 2023 joining program for Koonwarra was all paddock joining. We did not do an Al program in November 2022.

We purchased a half share in a new horn sire at the Tara Park Merino Stud on-property sale in 2023 which we used in the paddock joining. The ram was Lot 3, sired by 7447 with tag number 035.

All rams will have current fleece tests. Bodyweights will be done the week before the open day as will the meat index figures. This ensures all information above each ram is current and accurate on sale day.

NEWS FROM MERRIGNEE

Starting the year at GSSM was a satisfying event for Merrignee with some pleasing show results, topped off with Merrignee ram "Brocky" 21-087 being crowned the 2024 Supreme Exhibit, coming from the fine wool section. He was complimented by the four judges at Bathurst for his large frame, quality of fleece and excellent wool cover with its exceptional quantity through the hip and rump region and the back legs.

"Brocky" then headed to the 2024 Sydney Royal Easter Show where he was awarded Grand Champion Fine Wool Merino Ram. Shorn in Sydney by renowned Boorowa expert shear Ian Elkins, he cut 14.6kg of wool with a 12.4kg fleece after being skirted. His fleece measurements were 17.2 microns, 2.7 SD, 15.8 CV, 99.8% CF and 16.0 SpinF, with 122kgs bare shorn bodyweight.

Named "Brocky" after the famous motor racing driver, Peter Brock, the winner of the Bathurst 1000 many times over, 21-087 is from the MGN Glenpaen "Patriot" family.

Before being shedded for show, "Brocky" had been out working with 60 ewes for six weeks in March 2023 and so will have 12-monthold rams in the Merrignee 2024 on-property ram sale in early October. After Sydney, we collected 600 doses of semen, demonstrating his great constitution and fertility.

Also at Bathurst, Merrignee "Tank" 21-189 was awarded Grand Champion Superfine Merino Ram. Named for his very large frame and tremendously square build, "Tank" is from the DF family. He had previously been sashed Champion March Shorn Merino Ram at 2023 Australian Sheep and Wool Show as well as Champion March Shorn Superfine Merino Ram at 2023 Rabobank National Sheep Show before his GSSM 2024 success.

"Tank" will also have 12-month-old rams on offer at our onproperty ram sale on 11th October 2024. His fleece figures are 18.1 microns, 3.0 SD, 16.6 CV, 99.7% CF and 17.0 SpinF, with a fleece weight of 12.6kgs and bodyweight of 134kgs on 01.09.24.

Another Merrignee superfine show ram will also have progeny on offering at our annual ram sale. Reserve Superfine Ram behind 21-189 at Bathurst, he was also named Reserve Champion Superfine Ram at Sydney this year. This ram is a large framed superfine sire whose fleece tests for Sydney Show were 16.4 microns, 2.4 SD, 14.6 CV, 99.8% CF, 15.2 SpinF, with a fleece weight of 11.8kgs. Rounding out the show year, a Merrignee superfine ewe fleece won the Supreme Fleece Exhibit at the 2024 Rabobank National Merino Sheep Show in August. From a ewe that was Champion Superfine Wool Ewe at GSSM in February this year, this award reinforces the favourable opinions of judges across New South Wales and Victoria for our stud rams and our clients' fleeces in recent years.

Two Merrignee 2024 superfine show rams also had fleece wins this year at Dubbo. "Tank" 21-189's fleece became Champion Superfine Housed Ram Fleece, while "MK" 21-641's fleece was awarded Reserve Champion Superfine Ram Fleece, echoing his Reserve Champion Superfine Ram broad ribbon at Sydney Show.

Also at Dubbo, Merrignee won Champion Superfine March Shorn Poll Ram and Ewe. This success is developing into long-term genetic gain for Merrignee and onto our clients' commercial flocks as all these prize winning sires have 12-month-old rams in our upcoming Merrignee on-property ram sale on 11th October 2024.

Its been a great year with the Merrignee show sheep and seeing the quality fleeces performing so well in competitions has been very rewarding and satisfying for our stud.

In our previous newsletters, we've discussed the sire selection we use at Merrignee and the genetic traits we insist on before sires are used in the stud. These traits include fleece weights, micron and fleece figures, frame size, confirmation and the very definite attitude to bright, white and high quality style wool with correct crimp definition for our wool types.

To get these traits to be there for generations in stud and flock sheep takes a slower time frame to ensure they are locked in genetically. Merrignee aims is to ensure our clients' Merino sheep are continually improving these traits, leading to better profits for their businesses and the wider Merino sheep industry.

All sale rams were side sampled and weighed in early August 2024, with testing undertaken by Riverina Wool Testers in Wagga Wagga, to provide each ram with their fleece test. Body weights will be done just prior to the Merrignee open day. All figures will be available via cards above each pen and in the Merrignee on-property ram sale catalogue.

The Merrignee Merino type has had a hugely successful year in 2024 with our sire MGN "Brocky" 21-087 being the crowned Supreme Exhibit at GSSM at Bathurst in February, while MGN"The Tank" 21-189 and MGN"MK" 21-641 were awarded Champion and Reserve Champion Superfine rams at GSSM as well as the Sydney Royal Easter Show.

Then to top off the show year, Merrignee had the Supreme Champion Fleece at the Rabobank National Merino Sheep Show at Dubbo in August. This fleece was from our Champion Superfine Ewe at GSSM back in February.

The fact that these rams and ewes, along with their fleeces, won champion ribbons at various major NSW shows in 2024 gives us great confidence that our Merrignee sheep genetic gains are being acknowledged by recognised Merino industry judges.

We are very pleased that these winning sires were all used in March 2023 for stud paddock joinings to their ewe groups for six weeks. They backed up their AI ewe groups of up to 50/60 stud ewes.

After joining these sires are then fed to gain weight in a paddock before going into the shed to prepare for the show season. This system allows us to have their 12-month-old ram progeny in our on-property sales each year, giving our clients the opportunity to follow their achievements through the show circuit and then select their sons at our ram sale.

This year's sale team have plenty of frame with bulky fleeces, as you can imagine they should have having been sired by our successful show team rams. Perhaps the progeny by the sire MGN "Big Super"19-107 could be the "bell ringer". His ram group in this year's on-property sale are from an AI group of stud ewes, which he then backed up physically. His progeny have produced a high percentage of lambs which are as good as we have ever bred here at Merrignee.
